Parson Cross Forum Secures Grant from Awards for All for an Exciting New Project in the City SILENT WORDS

Parson Cross Forum are excited to announce that we have been successful in securing a grant from Awards for All to deliver a brand new project to Sheffield "SILENT WORDS". This is a pilot project that will improve the lives of people living with Dementia and their carers. We are creating a new group at Parson Cross Forum, offering both an activity for carers and JABADAO a Creative Communication group for the people with Dementia, run by a team of volunteers. The full Project will start in early January 2014 but we are hosting a Modeling Day to showcase what JABADAO is all about for both the participants and volunteers on Monday 4th November 1.00pm till 3.00pm. Places must be booked.

JABADAO is a fabulous community activity for people with Dementia and their families. Using movement as the shared language, the dancing happens both standing, but mostly seated in chairs. Lots of beautiful props are used that enable everyone to join in - in their own unique, full-bodied, wholehearted way. The dancers are expert in engaging everyone no matter how frail, or how boisterous. Working in partnership with the national training organisation JABADAO, we will be training a team of volunteers in non-verbal, creative communication techniques to support people with Dementia. JABADAO have 28 years experience of innovative training and Parson Cross Forum will be replicating the highly successful group that is currently running in Barnsley. The training will ensure that all of the volunteers who engage in the project are fully qualified to deliver JABADAO and everyone who participating in the project gets the best experience possible. We will link the project with the Dementia Friends campaign and volunteers will become Dementia Friends Champions as part of their training.
